Dear Mr. Cobb:

Your email complaint with attachments, dated April 30, 2010, to Office of the Inspector General, was forwarded to the Initial Processing Unit, Inspection Division (INSD), Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), for review. The IIS/INSD is the FBI entity responsible for investigating allegations of serious misconduct or criminal activity on the part of FBI employees.

In your complaint, you alleged that the FBI Field Office in Memphis and Special Agent in Charge (SAC) My Harrison have failed to investigate a report concerning the safety of the runway at the Memphis airport that you submitted to them in February 2010. You explained that when you did not hear anything from the FBI Field Office or SAC Harrison for a month following the submission of your complaint, you posted a certified mail receipt on their website. The next day you received a call from Special Agent Michael D. Saltsman, who told you that the FBI did not find any evidence of criminal activity in the matter and that the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) would have greater jurisdiction to investigate.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the IPU/INSD has reviewed your allegations and has determined that IPU will take no action as there is no evidence of FBI misconduct.
