This letter is to inform you of the results of the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) investigation of the air carrier safety aspects of your complaint against Federal Express Corporation under the Whistleblower Protection Program, 49 U.S.C. § 42121.

The FAA has completed its investigation of the safety allegations contained in your complaint. This investigation has not established a violation of an order, regulation, or standard relating to air carrier safety. Therefore, the FAA is closing its investigation concerning these allegations.

Please note that the FAA's disposition of the safety issues outlined in your complaint is independent of the U.S. Department of Labor's separate investigation into your allegations of discrimination.
