Dear Mr. Cobb:

I am contacting you in follow up to the complaint you submitted to the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Inspector General (DOL-OIG). This information has been reviewed by the Complaint Analysis Office. Specifically, you are requesting an investigation involving what you allege to be collusion between a FedEx attorney and Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Paul C. Johnson, in connection with your attempt to obtain a hearing before the Administrative Review Board, and an appeal decision made by ALJ Judge Paul Johnson.

The DOL-OIG primarily investigates allegations of fraud, waste or abuse involving U.S. Department of Labor programs and operations. The DOL-OIG generally does not initiate investigations or directly intervene in matters related to individual complaints, cases, claims or appeals, such as those you have reported.

I note that you have already filed an appeal with the Administrative Review Board (ARB) which is the most appropriate course of action.

I regret that the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Inspector General cannot be of further assistance regarding the concerns you reported.
